



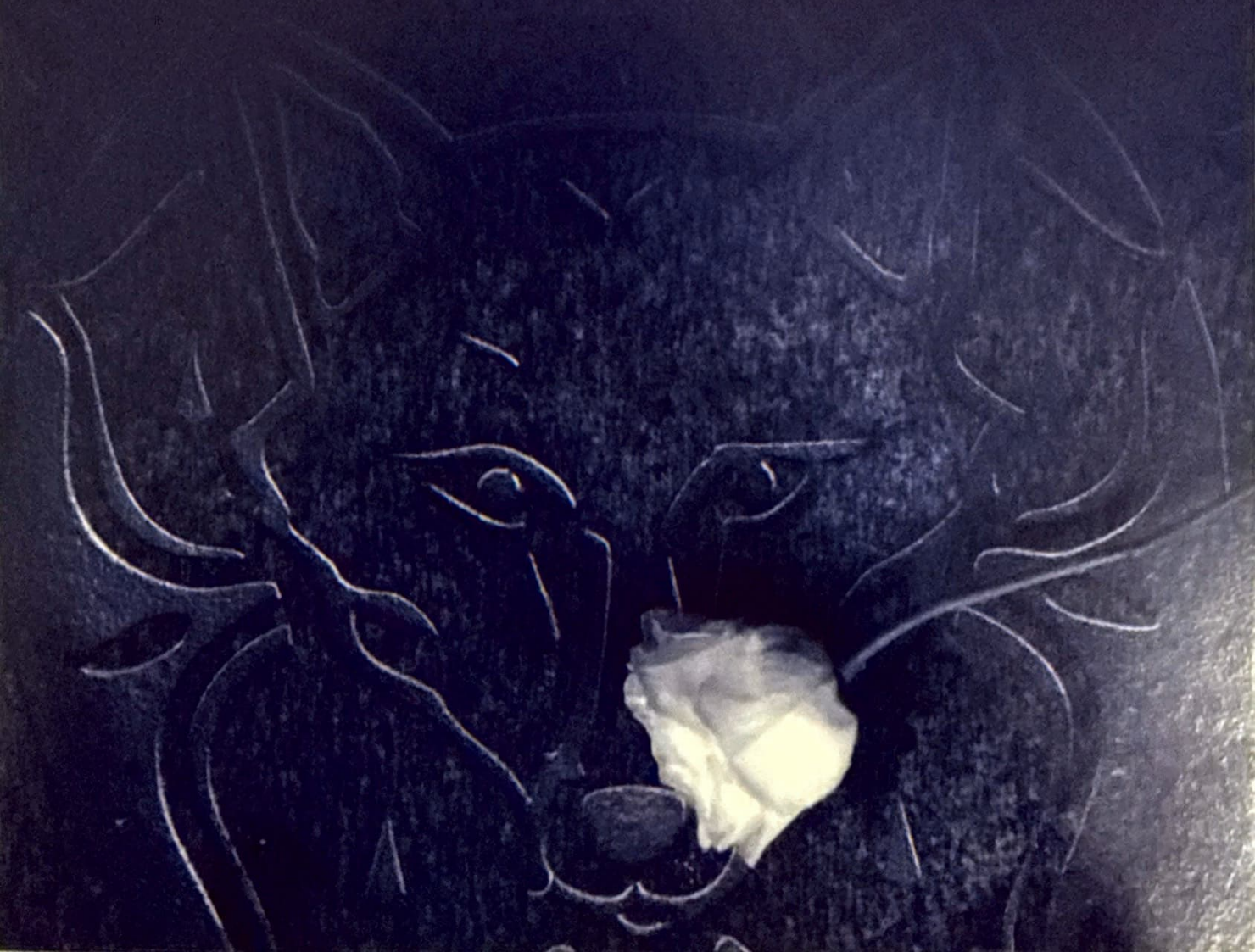
Welcome to the Leicester City
